

Isandlwana & Rorkes Drift Tour

Tour Itinerary



06h30 - Depart from ICC

Depart Durban and head North. Visit two of the most historical Battlefields of KwaZulu-Natal between the British and Zulu Armies.

Isandlwana Battlefield – In 1879 the British Camp was overrun by some 20 000 Zulus armed with traditional weapons. Cairns mark places where British soldiers fell and were later buried.

Rorke's Drift – In 1879 about 100 British soldiers fought for 11 hours to repel an attack by 4000 Zulu Warriors, earning 11 Victoria Crosses.

Spend time on the eerie battlefields while your guide gives you a detailed account of the wars of the region. Lunch will be taken en-route and is included. Return to Durban in the early evening +- 19H30
