08:30	Depart from ICC
<p>A short drive from the ICC and your tour commences at Tourist Junction, for the story of Gandhi's train journey in Durban, in 1893. Next stop is the Victoria Street Market where you will be able to enjoy some curio shopping and a spice demonstration. While we drive around the Grey Street area taking in the sights and sounds, your guide will give you the historical background to the Indian indentured labourers, you will pass the Juma Masjid Mosque and Muthi Market. A 20 minute drive out of the city takes us to the Inanda Heritage Route, to visit the first home of Mahatma Gandhi. In 1994, Inanda's outlook changed as democracy was born in South Africa. To mark the occasion, Nelson Mandela cast his vote in this historic election at Inanda's Ohlange Institute, fitting given that the first-ever president of the African National Congress (ANC), Dr. John L. Dube, established this school in 1901. Next we drive south to a Hindu Temple of Understanding - a spiritual wonderland. Enjoy a sumptuous Indian lunch before returning to the ICC.</p>
